Plot Assignment

Instructions: In order to demonstrate your understanding of the main events happening in your book, you are going to write two one-page letters. Each letter must follow the specifications below and must contain lots of details / examples from the book to back up what you are describing in the letter. Be interesting, Be creative, Be detailed. Show off your true understanding of the book up to this point.

- 1- Write a full-page letter to one of the characters in your novel. In your letter you could give your character advice, ask questions, describe your favorite part, make connections, and tell what part you liked most. Make sure you are describing in detail what is going on in this character's life, the problem they are faced with and key events that have occurred thus far in the story.
 - 2- Write a full-page letter to the author sharing your overall opinion of the novel. Include what your favorite parts were and who your favorite characters were. Explain to the author what you would have done differently if you were the author. Discuss how you would end the book if you were the author and make a prediction about how you think this conflict will be resolved. Make sure you include lots of detailed descriptions and specific examples from the book to back up what you are saying.
- Remember that your assignment should demonstrate your knowledge and understanding of the plot, as well as how you write the letter. The more plot details you include, the better you are going to be able to demonstrate your understanding of what is going on within the pages of your novel.
 - Be creative with your letters... have fun... find a way to incorporate your personality into your letters, so they seem like they are actual letters being sent to real people.
 - Also remember that these are friendly letters, so they should be written following that format.
