 1. An essay of 1,000 or more words on the theme – “**The Value Of Unions To The Workers And Society**”,
 - OR**
 - 2. A visual arts work (painting, song, poem, poster or sculpture) depicting “**The Value Of Unions To The Workers And Society**” together with a 500 word essay interpreting this theme.
- Preliminary judging of entries will be by an academic/arts panel and the final selection made by the NBFL Education Committee.
 - The winning entry shall be released to the media.
 - Applicants agree to allow display of their entry at the annual NBFL convention.
 - Entries, if requested, will be returned at the applicant’s expense.
